Sustainable Purchasing Policy

Brugarolas is a company committed to sustainability and aims to apply it throughout the entire supply chain. Therefore, Brugarolas is guided by ethical practices and responsible sourcing, working closely with suppliers to improve management and performance in pursuit of sustainability. We seek to promote a positive impact on both the environment and society, based on the following principles:

All raw materials come from sources certified under ISO 9001:2015 standard. Likewise, all our suppliers are required to complete a preliminary questionnaire to assess their level of commitment to sustainability to be approved.

Priority is given to suppliers with a clear environmental commitment, particularly in areas such as GHG emissions, energy efficiency and renewable energy, decarbonization, and the quality of air, soil, and water, as well as noise emissions.

Working only with suppliers that follow ethical labor practices, those who respect human rights, women's rights, fair wages and ethical hiring, and those who promote diversity, equity, and inclusion. Not with those who do not tolerate child labor, discrimination and harassment, or unsafe working conditions.

Support for local trade and reduction of environmental impact is encouraged by prioritizing local suppliers whenever possible.

Working with suppliers that implement Circular Economy practices, promoting recycling and waste reduction, improving resource efficiency, extending product lifespan, and enabling material recovery, thereby minimizing environmental impact throughout the supply chain.

Ensure transparency in all purchasing operations by maintaining visibility and traceability across the supply chain.

Priority is given to suppliers that avoid hazardous substances, offer safer alternatives, and promote innovation as part of continuous improvement, while managing chemicals responsibly.

Uphold ethics in anti-corruption, anti-bribery, fair competition, anti-monopoly, financial responsibility, anti-counterfeiting, and anti-money laundering, with a zero-tolerance policy for any supplier failing to comply with these ethical standards.
